BENEFITS FOR BUSINESSES

Save money on sales tax for building & maintenance materials

The Illinois Quad Cities Enterprise Zone is a geographically based program designed to stimulate economic growth in specific areas of the Illinois Quad Cities. Through a quick application process, your company can stop paying sales tax on building and maintenance materials.

WHO QUALIFIES?


- Businesses located in the Enterprise Zone (Scan QR code to see if you qualify)
- For purchase of building improvements materials of at least \$10,000



ELIGIBLE EXPENSES INCLUDE

- Building materials such as lumber, bricks, cement, windows, doors, insulation, roofing materials, sheet metals
- Plumbing and electrical components
- Heating and cooling systems
- Built-in cabinets and other woodwork which are physically incorporated into the real estate
- Built-in appliances such as refrigerators, stoves, ovens, trash compactors
- Floor coverings such as tile, linoleum, carpeting

TAKE THESE STEPS TO RECEIVE ENTERPRISE ZONE BENEFITS

- Confirm your company is located in the Illinois Quad Cities Enterprise Zone.
- Apply by contacting 
- Receive your Tax Exemption certificate(s) for your company and/or vendors
- Get immediate sales tax savings upon purchase of materials
- Repeat annually for continued savings

Illinois QC Enterprise Zone Administrator
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Special notes:

If your facility is not currently in the zone, the boundaries can be amended to include properties in Rock Island, Moline, East Moline, Milan, Silvis and unincorporated Rock Island County.

This program can only be used by the building owner. If a company leases space in the Enterprise Zone and makes improvements to the facility, the landlord of the property will need to be involved in the application process.
